1. This Contest is open to all students in Grades 7 and 8. All posters will be submitted to the Right to Life Association of Thunder Bay for judging.
2. All drawings must pertain to the Pro-Life theme stated above.
3. Poster drawings should be in bold, bright colors using 8 ½" x 11" white art paper/photocopy paper, paints, markers and/or crayons. (Posters will not be accepted if they are not the correct size as they may be used in a local pro-life calendar).
4. Drawings should be freehand. Please do not paste magazine pictures or computer-generated drawings onto posters. Drawings may contain some words.
5. Drawings will be judged based on, creativity, clarity of message and visual appeal.
6. The winning drawings will become property of the RTL Association of Thunder Bay and may be used for advertising and educational purposes.
7. First place winners will receive a \$75.00 cash prize. Second place winners will receive \$50.00. Two winning choices for 'Honourable Mention' will each receive \$20.00.
8. Winners will be announced by the end of May 2009. Winners will be contacted and asked to supply a school-type photo, which will also be used for advertising and educational purposes.
9. All posters submitted for judging, except for those of the winners, will be returned to the participating schools.
